<u>Transportation from London airports to the Institute of Education, UCL</u> From Heathrow

Heathrow is approximately 20 miles (32km) to the west of central London.

- By taxi/cab: Taxis stop at the ranks outside every Heathrow terminal. All black cabs are fully licensed. The journey from Heathrow to University College London (UCL) will cost approximately 60-80 GBP.
- By private car: Heathrow's chauffeur services offer a fixed-price trip to or from any UK destination. Book online either with Chaufferit or TriStar Worldwide.



- By London Underground (the "Tube"): London's public transportation system is excellent and may be faster than cabs, particularly at rush hour. To travel directly from Heathrow to UCL, take the Piccadilly line to Russell Square. This takes about an hour. From there, the venue is about a fourminute walk. Piecae-click here for walking directions. This Tube trip will cost about 6 GBP.
- Heathrow Express: This service operates four non-stop trains per hour to and from Paddington Station in central London. The journey time between the three stations at Heathrow (Terminals 1, 2, 3) and (Terminals 4 and 5) is 15-20 minutes. Passengers for Terminal 4 must change at Terminals 1, 2, 3 for the free and frequent transfer service to Terminal 4. More information is available on the Heathrow Express website.

From **Gatwick**

Gatwick is 30 miles (48km) to the south of central London.

- By rail: <u>The Gatwick Express</u> operates four trains per hour to and from London Victoria. Journey time is approximately 30 minutes. There is no service between 00:30 and 03:30 from London and between 01:35 and 04:35 from Gatwick.
- Other rail operators run services through the night. <u>Southern Trains</u> operates three trains per hour to and from London Victoria; the average journey time is 40 minutes. <u>Thameslink</u> trains operate up to four trains per hour to and from London Bridge, City Thameslink, Farringdon and St. Pancras International.

From London City Airport

City Airport has a dedicated station on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR). Journey times are 18 minutes to Canary Wharf and 22 minutes to Bank. From there, you can take other underground trains to get to Russell Square Station, which is a four-minute walk to the venue.

From international train stations

The venue is a 15-minute walk from St. Pancras International Train Station. Alternatively, take the Piccadily Underground line one stop from King's Cross St. Pancras to Russell Square. From there, the venue is a four-minute walk.

Getting around London

- <u>The Transport for London</u> website is essential for planning journeys within London.
- Travelers may also use Hailo (for black cabs) and/or Uber (for minicabs/non-black cabs). They can be downloaded and used to request cabs in central London. Alternatively, any black cab that has an orange light can be hailed in London.
