ICHOM – Background:

ICHOM is a non-profit organisation committed to transforming healthcare to a value-based system through universal measurement and reporting of patient outcomes. ICHOM was co-founded in 2012 by Professor Michael Porter of Harvard Business School, Stefan Larsson from the Boston Consulting Group, and Professor Martin Ingvar of the Karolinska Institute. Its mission is to unlock the potential of Value-Based health care to improve outcomes that really matter to patients while improving health care spending.

ICHOM brings together leading global experts in a number of initiatives. Developing quality assured standard sets with outcome measures for important disease groups is at the core of what we do. In addition, we have set up a Partnership Programme to offer providers implementation support of the sets, created ICHOM Connect community where healthcare professionals can meet and discuss their projects, and launched a Conference Series to create the network and conversations needed around outcome measurement globally.

In 2021, we are taking the next big step to further ICHOM's mission, while at the same time moving towards becoming a self-sustained organisation. We will do this by pioneering global benchmarking of outcomes and build a platform with the ambition to transform health care. The platform will enable providers globally to collect and compare outcome data efficiently and at scale and provide the basis for outcomes improvement. We are partnering with a tech company to build this new business together, combining our expertise in outcome measures with their technical capabilities and experience in health care benchmarking platforms. We are now seeking the person to lead this new opportunity.

Job description:

As the Programme Manager, you will lead the development of this new business together with our technology partner. You will balance strategic analysis with execution in a fast-paced and iterative set-up. Understand the needs and lead innovation that creates true value for our customers. Ultimately, you will be an integral part to further our mission of better outcomes for patients and help us become a self-sustained organisation. You will oversee:

- The creation of the global benchmarking platform that will transform how providers collaborate and improve health outcomes, building on cutting edge technological innovations
- Work with ICHOM and its working groups to develop measurement KPIs and risk adjustment algorithms
- Help build an ecosystem of tech and implementation partners that will support the transformation
- Work with Sales and Marketing to take the product to market

- Participate in strategic and operational committees to unsure that the project remains on track and aligned with strategic goals
- Ensure the project's delivery ensuring business goals and met
- Manage the budget
- Proactively flag any issues and develop creative solutions to roadblocks
- Conduct key analysis to support strategic decision-making
- Collaborate with Partnerships staff to create an ecosystem of regional tech partners and implementation partners together with our team

- Work together with our working groups and our Director of Outcomes research, ensuring the benchmarking of outcomes on the platform is grounded in science

- Develop great collaboration across work streams within the project, with the broader organization and with our tech partner
