International Consortium for Health Outcomes Measurement (ICHOM) is a non-profit organisation created in 2012 by the founders and early pioneers of value based healthcare to address the challenge of achieving the standardized measurement of outcomes. At ICHOM, our mission is to unlock the potential of value-based healthcare by defining what matters most to patients and encouraging the adoption and reporting of these measures worldwide to make life better for all. This takes the form of ICHOM's Sets of Patient-Centered Outcome Measures: we have produced 45 Sets to date, covering different conditions and for specific patient populations. By creating a standardized list of the outcomes based on the patient's priorities, along with instruments and time points for measurement, we can ensure the patient remains at the centre of their care. Over 500 hospitals and clinics currently use ICHOM Sets but our ambition is to make them the foundation of care pathways in every healthcare system around the world.

- Support systematic reviews of the literature including in-depth analysis of Patient Reported Outcome Measures for given disease area.
- Support the set development process:
 - Document minutes and decisions taken during expert calls.
 - Survey development and analysis.
 - Final materials development (examples: <https://connect.ichom.org/>).
- Support community engagement and marketing of ICHOM Set materials.
- Support harmonisation and update of ICHOM term bank

- Additional projects as needed.
