- 2 Tracked via FACE-QKIDS - Appearance of the face
- 3 Evaluated via eating and drinking questions
- 4 Evaluated via speech questions
- 5 Tracked via Visual Analogue Scale

- 6 Evaluated via Snellen Chart
- 7 Evaluated via ocular symptoms questions
- 8 Tracked via PROMIS Paediatric Global Health
- 9 Tracked via PROMIS Peer-Relationships
