
# **ICHOM** Major Injury

- 3 Reported using ASSIST-LITE
- 4 Reported using PC-PTSD
- 5 Including Physical Health and Global Functioning
- 6 Injury-specific functioning additionally reported for relevant patients using MPAI-4 (TBI), SCIM-SR (SCI), and BSHS-B (burns)
- 7 Including Musculoskeletal Function and Ambulatory Function
- 8 Reported using PROMIS Sleep Disturbance 8b
- 9 Reported using PROMIS Satisfaction with Sex Life
- 10 Including Activities of Daily Living and Autonomy
- 11 Including Changes in Employment
- 12 Reported using MPAI-4 for patients with head injuries
