Kuipers trained as gastroenterologist and is renowned for his research on gastrointestinal cancer. He contributed to international guidelines and advised governments and societies across the globe on cancer screening. He received various international awards and was declared as most influential person in Dutch healthcare. He was installed by King Willem-Alexander of the Netherlands as Officer in the Order of Orange-Nassau in 2024.
